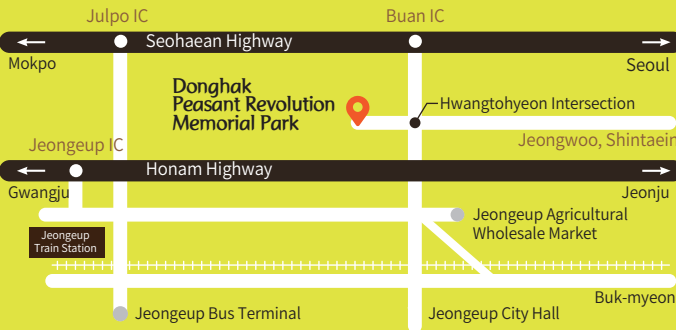
By Train

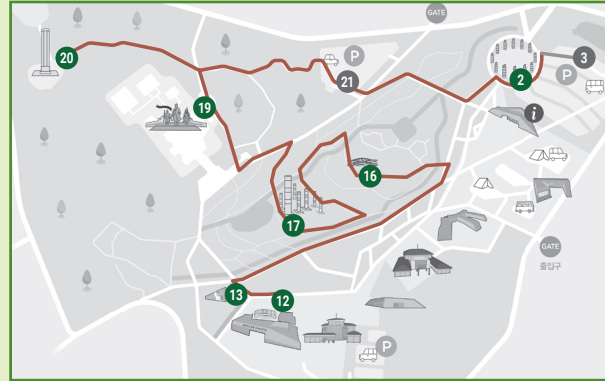

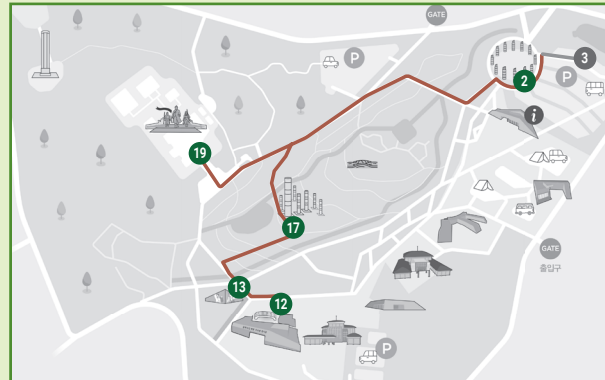

DONGHAK PEASANT REVOLUTION MEMORIAL PARK





Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial Park

Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial Park, built in the whole area of Hwangtohyeon battlefield(historic site no. 295), is the first victory site of the Donghak Peasant which was opened on May, 11, 2022 to spread historical value of Donghak Peasant Revolution to the nation and to honor its participants' spirits. The Donghak Peasant Revolution Museum and Memorial Hall, campsite, stuying and training center, visitor center and a cafeteria are located in the park. Also, commemorative monuments such as Sabaltongmun(Bowl Manifesto) Plaza, Pillar of Resonance, Path of Donghak Peasant Revolution, Field of Memories, Wall of Peasant, Symbolic Sculpture(Bamboo Spear Resolution), Immortal-Wind path(The Statue of General Jeon Bong-jun and the Donghak Peasant Army) are made around the park.

Sabaltongmun (Bowl Manifesto) Plaza

This Plaza represents Sabaltongmun(Bowl Manifesto) composed in November, 1893. The sticks symbolize bamboo spears and the pointed ovals at the upper part of the sticks represent torchlights.



Pillar of Resonance

These memorial sculptures symbolize the 90 regions nationwide that revolt during the Donghak Peasant Revolution in 1894.



Path of Donghak Peasant Revolution

This is the road from the entrance of the park to the museum. Walking through this historic site, where the Donghak Peasant Army courageously won their battle, you can almost feel their breath.



Field of Memories

This field revived the natural environment at the time of the Donghak Peasant Revolution in 1894.



Wall of Peasant

This is outer wall of Donghak Peasant Revolution Museum which represents the determined attitudes of the Donghak Peasant Army through a stone method formative art.

Symbolic Sculpture Bamboo Spear Resolution

It is an artistic representation of the process of young bamboo shoots that turn into bamboos and into bamboo spears.



Immortal-Wind path

The statue of General Jeon Bong-jun and the Donghak Peasant Army. This sculpture is an artistic representation of the Donghak Peasant Army's going to the battle.



Donghak Peasant Revolution Museum

Donghak Peasant Revolution Museum consists of the Exhibition Hall and the Memorial Hall.

Exhibition Hall



A place where anyone can easily understand the history of the Donghak Peasant Revolution and its significance to the world as well as East-Asian history by looking at various explanatory panels, relics and videos.

Memorial Hall



This is the place for commemorating Gabo ancestors' honorable sprits enshrining Donghak Peasant Revolution Participants' ancestral tatblets.

Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial Hall

Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial, has been managed by the Donghak Peasant Revolution Foundation given the trust from Jeollabuk-do. This Memorial has two-stories and a basement equipped with a permanent exhibition hall, special exhibition hall, exhibition hall for children and seminar room(open data room). It holds special exhibitions biannually, purchases artifacts, and provides various training programs.
