





# ©Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial Park

Donghak Peasant Revolution Memorial Park, built in the whole area of Hwangtohyeon battlefield(historic site no. 295), is the first victory site of the Donghak Peasant which was opened on May, 11, 2022 to spread historical value of Donghak Peasant Revolution to the nation and to honor its participants' spirits. The Donghak Peasant Revolution Museum and Memorial Hall, campsite, stuying and training center, visitor center and a cafeteria are located in the park. Also, commemorative monuments such as Sabaltongmun(Bowl Manifesto) Plaza, Pillar of Resonance, Path of Donghak Peasant Revolution, Field of Memories, Wall of Peasant, Symbolic Sculpture(Bamboo Spear Resolution), Immortal-Wind path(The Statue of General Jeon Bong-jun and the Donghak Peasant Army) are made around the park.

Sabaltongmun (Bowl Manifesto) Plaza

This Plaza represents Sabaltongmun(Bowl Manifesto) composed in November, 1893. The sticks symbolize bamboo spears and the pointed ovals at the upper part of the sticks represent torchlights.





Pillar of Resonance These memorial sculptures symbolize the 90 regions nationwide that revolt during the Donghak Peasant Revolution in 1894.



Path of Donghak Peasant Revolution

This is the road from the entrance of the park to the museum. Walking through this historic site, where the Donghak Peasant Army courageously won their battle, you can almost feel their breath.


